FOREWORD

Gender norms and gender relations that perpetuate inequities and violate the rights of women and girls fuel their susceptibility to HIV. Women and girls often have less information about HIV and as a result of stigmatizing attitudes towards females carrying condoms, unequal power relations, sexual violence and economic dependency which inhibits their ability to negotiate safer sex, they are often unable to take preventative measures. Addressing gender inequities and mainstreaming gender in the national HIV response are key components to reducing the risk of HIV transmission and increasing access to HIV prevention, care and treatment services.

This Directory of Services was developed based on the findings documented in the report on the *Human Rights Issues confronted by HIV Positive Women in Jamaica*. These interviews that were conducted with 28 HIV positive women from urban and rural Jamaica, indicated that access to information on HIV and AIDS, and moreover, on their sexual and reproductive health and rights, required strengthening.

In this regard, Jamaica AIDS Support for Life compiled this Directory of Services which contains a listing of HIV/AIDS outreach agencies, health care services, women's rights organizations and educational training programmes. It is intended that this directory will be useful to the public and specifically to individuals most at-risk for HIV, persons living with HIV and AIDS and to stakeholders who serve these populations.

The compilation of this resource was made possible through the UN Women-European Commission project, entitled: *Supporting Gender Equality in the context of HIV and AIDS.* Jamaica AIDS Support for Life, as the civil society partner in Jamaica has supported this project through numerous initiatives, including capacity building, advocacy training and providing access to income-generating and education grants.

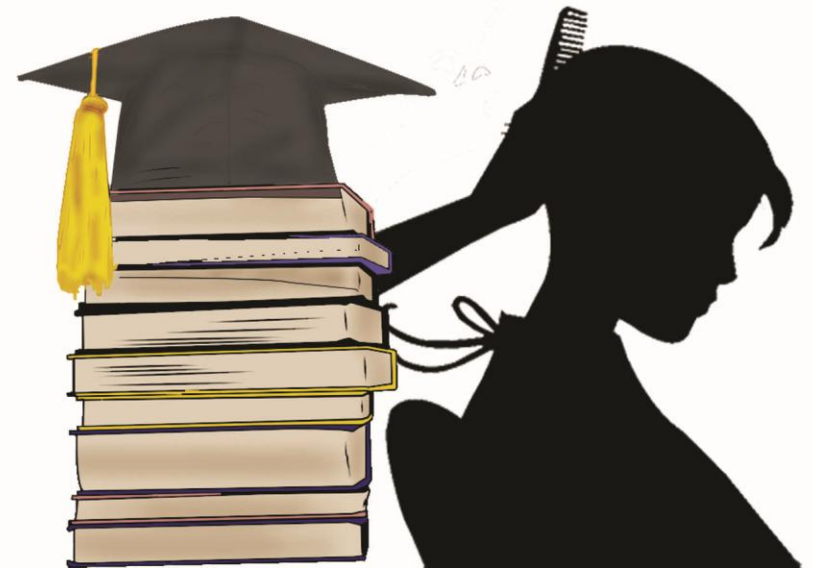
